Deemed Status Notice

(11166)

Tells people they automatically qualify for Extra Help.

Auto-Enrollment Notice

(11154 & 11429)

Tells people with Medicare and Medicaid and people with retroactive Extra Help that they'll be automatically enrolled in a drug plan if they don't enroll themselves or decline coverage.

Facilitated Enrollment Notice

(11186 & 11191)

Tells people who qualify for Extra Help that they'll be automatically enrolled in a drug plan if they don't enroll themselves or decline coverage.

FBDE RDS Notice

(11334)

Tells people with Medicare and Medicaid who already have certain credible drug coverage from an employer/union that they automatically qualify for Extra Help and can join a Part D plan at no cost to them.

Social Security Initial IRMAA Determination Notice

Tells people with Part B and/or Part D whether any IRMAA amounts apply to them.
